



Instruction Sheet for Behavior Tracking Form

- Thank you for volunteering to help observe community actions that may be having a detrimental effect on the water quality of Lake Tapps.
- The goal of the observational phase of this study is to ***identify potential target behaviors that, if changed, would have the greatest positive effect on Lake Tapps water quality.***
- Please take careful notes on the attached **behavior tracking form** so that we can capture key details.
- This is meant to be a visual only observation. Please do not intercept or intervene to influence behavior.
- There is no need to note who is engaged in any behaviors you observe. However, it is important to note how many of these behaviors are occurring, and how often they are taking place.
