

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE LAKE TAPPS RESERVIOR FLOWLINE OUTAGE PROJECT

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: Assessment, maintenance, and repair of various features in the Lake Tapps Reservoir Flowline. See attached Project scope.

PROPONENT AND LEAD AGENCY: Cascade Water Alliance

LOCATION OF PROPOSAL, INCLUDING STREET ADDRESS, IF ANY: The Project is located in northern Pierce County, WA, approximately 30 miles southeast of Seattle and 18 miles east of Tacoma in Section 2, Township 19 North, Range 6 East. The Project comprises facilities that divert water from the White River and supply it to the Lake Tapps Reservoir. Facilities include a headworks intake structure, a fish screen, and approximately 7.5 miles of flumes, canals, dikes, basins, and pipes. Collectively, these facilities are referred to as the "Flowline." See attached maps.

THRESHOLD DETERMINATION: The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c).
