Pre-Submission Meeting Questions and Answers

May 29, 2019

Q:	Are you looking for recommendations for Capital Improvement projects or meter condition assessments?
A:	It's site specific. Cascade would need to work with its members to determine what we need the consultant to evaluate.
Q:	Do you also expect the consultant to do a cost estimate in addition to what was on the scope?
A:	Yes, cost estimating is expected when needed.
Q:	Is your SCADA system ready if the meter vault has telemetry?
A:	Cascade does not have its own SCADA for in-town meters. Existing meters that have SCADA belong to Cascade's members.
Q:	Will your counsel be closely involved in this program as with other past programs?
A:	Counsel will be engaged in preparing transfer and authorization documents. If there are exceptions to what is already adopted, counsel will be more engaged.
Q:	Are there franchise agreements between Cascade and where the meter is getting transferred to Cascade?
A:	We don't anticipate that franchise agreements are needed but need to confirm that with our members.
