- 4. Items Recommended for Action at the September 23, 2026 Board Meeting**
 - A. Capital Funding Plan Resolution.** [Materials for this Agenda Item are still being finalized and will be transmitted in an amended packet prior to the meeting]
 - B. 2027-2028 Budget Resolution.** The 2027-2028 Budget Resolution authorizes Cascade's biennial budget for the coming two years. As required by Cascade Code, it defines the authorized uses of funds, Cascade staffing levels, the resources to provide those needed funds, the 2027-2032 Capital Improvement Program, and the fund management rules Cascade will follow. Staff has previously presented to the committee throughout the 2027-2028 Budget Development Process and will present a summary of items that have changed since the Draft Final Budget was presented in July.  - C. 2027-2028 Rates and Charges Resolution.** The 2027-2028 Rates and Charges Resolution establishes the Member charges for the coming biennium. It is based on the charge methodology established in Cascade Code. The charge calculation process is described in an attached memorandum, and Cascade Members have had the opportunity to review, provide corrections and feedback. There are no changes to the Draft Final materials that were presented in July. (Attachment)
 - D. 2027-2028 Regional Capital Facilities Charge Resolution.** The 2027-2028 Regional Capital Facilities Charges Resolution establishes the Regional Capital Facilities Charges ("RCFCs") per Cascade Equivalent Residential Unit ("CERU") for the coming biennium. It is based on the charge methodology established in Cascade Code. There are no changes to the Draft Final materials that were presented in July. (Attachment)

- E. Finance Code Updates Resolution.** As part of preparation for the 2026 Bond, a number of code updates relating to finance matters have been prepared. These consist of updating the fund name for the Rate Stabilization Fund, strengthening the target balance for the Rate Stabilization Fund, and housekeeping updates to reflect prior Board intent. (Attachment)
- F. 2026 Bond Resolution.** The Bond Resolution authorizes Cascade to issue bonds for the amounts, purposes, and with the terms and covenants specified in the resolution. The resolution does not set the interest rates or final bond sizing but authorizes Cascade to issue amounts up to the specified threshold, with flexibility to issue less as appropriate based on market conditions and Cascade's financial strategy. - G. Financial Advisor Contract.** Northwest Municipal Advisors (NWMA) has served as Cascade's financial advisors for every public bond issue, and they are currently supporting Cascade in the planning of the upcoming bond issuance. When Cascade executed the last contract with NWMA, we did not anticipate a bond issuance at that time, and it was excluded from the contract. This action is to execute an agreement for up to \$100,000 to serve as financial advisors for the upcoming bond issuance. (Attachment)
